 *** If the student receives a grade of a “D”, “F”, or an “Incomplete” or withdraws from a course after the college drop deadline, the student and the student’s parent or guardian may be required to pay the school district for the tuition of the course.

The Fee schedule is a result of Colorado State Law (CRS 22-32-117 and 118). The law requires the following:

- *Any fee collected shall be used for the purpose set forth...and shall not be expended for any other purpose.*
- *A complete list of fees, how the amount of each fee was derived, and the purpose of each fee shall be made available upon request.*
- *Any publication listing fees shall clearly state whether the fee is mandatory or voluntary and specify the activity from which the student will be excluded if it is not paid.*

In order to be in compliance, each school must keep on file this District Wide Fee Sheet and its own fee sheet.
