



**DISTRICT ACCOUNTABILITY COMMITTEE RESOLUTION REGARDING THE DPS-DCTA Contract Negotiations (January 2019)**

whereas, The District Accountability Committee has the obligation to provide community perspective regarding crucial decisions and workings of the Denver Board of Education and Denver Public Schools at large;

whereas, The District Accountability Committee recognizes significant flexibility and the spirit of compromise between Denver Public Schools and the Denver Classroom Teachers Association;

whereas, The District Accountability Committee recognizes that the shared goal of all parties is to keep schools open with highly qualified educators and specialized service providers present for students;

whereas, The District Accountability Committee recognizes that DCTA and DPS are on the precipice of an agreement and are characterized by the narrowest monetary and philosophical gap to date in the process;

It is Resolved that the District Accountability Committee recommends and stands in favor of:

- Compromise between the two parties through:
  - Adoption of the DCTA salary schedule submitted as of January 18th, 2019
  - Adoption of the DPS equity incentives (Highest Priority, Title I) submitted as of January 18th, 2019; addressing the costs associated with these incentives through further adjustments of the centrally-controlled budget.
